- Revise all the work done in class till date.

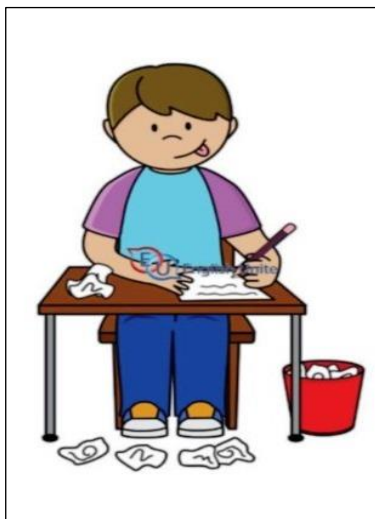
